

International students arriving in France **must register themselves for the compulsory Social Security (CPAM)**. This must be done as soon as possible after your arrival in France and **after their administrative registration with their higher education institution**. Students will be covered from the date of their administrative registration retroactively.

NON EU STUDENTS

Inscription online only:

- ➔ 1) Connect on the dedicated website <https://etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/>
- ➔ 2) Fill your circumstances, birth date and nationality
- ➔ 3) Fill your personal information: name, surname, birthdate, nationality, birthplace, date of entitlement start (administrative registration), postal address in France, email, phone number
- ➔ 4) Upload your documents:
 - Proof of registration for the current academic year
 - Proof of identity
 - Student visa
 - Vital record (original and translation combined into one document)
 - Residence permit (attestation of visa validation)
 - RIB (bank account identity)
- ➔ 5) After the uploaded documents are processed and conform download your temporary attestation of affiliation which includes the provisory number (15 figures). To be refund after a medical visit, you have to send your care sheet to the CPAM of your residence
- ➔ 6) Within the upcoming months you will received your definitive attestation and the social security number (13 figures)
- ➔ 6) In order to ease the refund of your medical expenses, you need to:
 - Create an account with the definitive number on www.ameli.fr
 - Order your « carte vitale »
 - Declare your referring doctor

STUDENTS FROM EU/EEE/SUISSE/MONEGASQUE

They remain covered by the health insurance of their country thanks to the European Health Insurance Card previously requested from the health agency of their country.

However, they can request a refund for medical cares from the CPAM of their place of study by filling out a CERFA form available on Ameli.fr.
