

Compulsory insurance, known as social security, covers 70% of the cost of medical expenses

Students benefit from their health care expenses in case of sickness or maternity. To benefit from compulsory health insurance, only one contact: CPAM (Primary Health Insurance Fund). Membership is free of charge!

WHICH AFFILIATION ACCORDING TO YOUR PROFILE?

- **New European student:** You keep the health insurance coverage of your home country. Refund of health expenses is paid after obtaining the European Health Insurance Card.

- **You are a non-European foreign student:** You must register on the dedicated website etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/ by filling in your personal information and uploading the requested documents
- **You have a double nationality European and non-European,** you enter in France without visa with your European nationality but you are not a European resident: You must register on the dedicated website etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr/#/

COMPLEMENTARY HEALTH INSURANCE

As the name indicates, it completes the mandatory health insurance, in particular for the refund of the remaining expenses (about 30 %), after social security. On the other hand, some services are not very well reimbursed (dental and optical expenses, as well as emergency services) or not at all reimbursed (naturopathy, osteopathy, etc.). It is not obligatory but strongly advised!

Which complementary to choose?

The amount reimbursed by the health supplement varies according to your needs. It is important to carefully consider the proposed offer before selecting a contract. The complementary may be your parents' or other private insurance or student insurance.

Students with limited financial resources also have the opportunity to subscribe to a CPAM health supplement called Complémentaire Santé Solidaire.

Summary for properly refund:

- Create your account on Ameli.fr, or on the Ameli mobile app: up-to-date mailing address, email, RIB, etc.
- Update vital card in pharmacy or CPAM office.
 - Declare a treating physician
 - Subscribing to complementary health
